New Leash on Life is a well-respected not-for-profit animal welfare organization that provides services to thousands of animals and people each year with our family of programs. In 2009, **New Leash on Life's Almost Home Pet Adoption Center** became a no-kill facility and maintained a **95% adoption rate**, our **Spay Station** performed **3,301** spay/neuter surgeries, **Snip & Tip**, New Leash on Life's feral cat trap/neuter/return program, sterilized over **715** felines and **Fix for Life**, our low cost spay/neuter clinic, performed over **8,415** surgeries. That's a total of over **12,000** dogs and cats spayed or neutered just this year - we are **saving lives through prevention!** We currently provide **432** elementary classrooms in 16 schools in the Wilson County and the Lebanon Special School District with a humane education program called *Kind News*.
